8 or more unauthorised absences could result in being referred for a penalty notice. Each day equates to two sessions meaning 8 sessions is 4 days.

This equates to a total of **2.42 days** of lost learning time!

Any child coming into the classroom after 9am is given a late mark, and after 9.20am is given an unauthorised absence.
