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Attendance & Lateness

Our whole school target this year is **95%.**Attendance will be a focus for our school this year. Our attendance is below what is expected of us by the government and poor attendance also has a huge effect on your child's learning.

Please make sure your child is in school and on time. Any child coming into the classroom after 9am is given a late mark and after 9.20am is given an unauthorised absence. The school gates open at 8.40am for the children to enter school.



Library Books

The library will be open for children to borrow books from 25th September. If you have books at home that need returning please give them to the class teachers.

New Entrances

There are now 3 different ways that children can come into school or leave at the end of the day. There is the original pathway, the new ramp or families can enter using the front gates, cross the zebra crossing then walk along the side of the school and in through the gate on the playground.

The purpose of the new entrances was so that no child had to cross a vehicle gate on their way to school. Please make full use of all of the entrances and if you are not sure just ask a member of staff.

Circus

To celebrate the event we will also be having a non-uniform day on Friday 15th September. For £1 donation the children can dress up in bright clothes for the day. They may wear funny wigs but NO masks please. We look forward to a bright and colourful Friday.

Uniform & Water Bottles

It is lovely to see all of the children coming back in uniform. Please make sure all items of clothing are labelled with your child's name. We have 2 bags of lost property from last term, none of which has any children's names in.

Children need to have PE kits in school from Year 1 upwards. Reception children will need to bring in a PE kit from Term 2 onwards.

Children may bring in a water bottle from home to drink from while they are working. This must have their child's name on and be filled with water or very weak sugar free squash.

Phonics and SATS Results

We have recently found out how our Y6 children did during the SATs tests they took in May. Our Y1 children also took a phonics test in early June. We are very pleased to see our results have improved again this year and at Y6 we are getting closer to the national average. This year each child in Y6 represented 5%.
