

Another reminder, our school hours will be changing from January 2024 due to new government expectations that schools are open to children for 32.5 hours a week or 6.5 hours a day.

We will open the gates for children to come in at 8:40am and the register will be taken at 8:50am. This means all children will need to be in school and in class by 8:50am.


Children will be marked with an L code until 9am and after 9am children will get a U Code. If a child has eight U codes in a ten week period you are likely to receive a penalty notice.

Reception, Year I and Year 2 will finish at 3:20pm.

Year 3, Year 4, Year 5 and Year 6 will finish at 3:25pm, so we can get everyone safely to their adults at the end of the day.

Breakfast club will continue to start at 8am and will remain free for children.

Nursery hours will stay the same as their entitlements are different.

What's a sound walk?

It's a walk, but you wear headphones and when you get to certain locations, your smart phone magically plays some recorded sound that we've placed there.

Where are the walks?

The walks are in Southmead (BS10), Bishopworth and Withywood (BS13) and Stockwood (BS14).

What do I need to bring?

A charged smartphone, headphones and sturdy footwear. We advise you download the free Echoes soundwalk app and the sound walk you're attending in advance, using wifi. The links can be found by clicking the links below.


Extraordinary Streets: Stockwood Spaceships, snall races and much more besides
