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Partial Reopening of Woodlands

It has been lovely to welcome some children back to Woodlands this week. We are sorry we are unable to have all children back in but with the current government guidelines in place we have opened the school to as many as we can.


We are still running provision for key worker children. If you feel you are a keyworker and will need to send your child to school please contact the office to request a place. As all of the teachers are now teaching a class they are unable to provide as much on line learning as before. If you are shielding we can provide packs of learning for your child to do at home. If your child is in Years 2, 3, 4 or 5 their class teacher will post work on google classroom once a week. They will not be able to respond to it during the week as they are teaching but will respond to it at the end of the week. Work will **not** be provided for Reception, Year I or Year 6 children who are not in school as their teacher is planning and teaching for their year groups bubbles.

For those children that have returned they are receiving as much of a normal curriculum as we can deliver, with the focus being on reading, writing, maths and phonics to help them catch up on the learning they have missed. They can change their reading books once a week but will not be taking home any homework or spellings.

If you initially said your child would not be returning but have changed your mind please contact the school office to arrange a date for your child to return.

Please note, for any child coming back to school, in either Reception, Year 1, Year 6 or as a key worker child, we need a week's notice before they can return.



Induction for new Reception and Nursery Children

We are in the process of arranging induction for children joining us in September in Nursery and Reception. We are unable to say how these will run at the moment but will be in contact with you over the next week. If your child is due to start Reception in September please make sure you have applied for a place or accepted any place you have been offered.

WELCOME TO YOUR NEW ACTIVITY PACKS

You are one of the lucky 20 families in Stockwood to receive a Lottery funded Activity Pack. This is part of a citywide initiative organised by Playful Bristol.

Here at APE Project we run St Paul's Adventure Playground as well a several other play services throughout the city. Our project in Stockwood project was originally supposed to be a Play Ranger Service for Stockwood offering a weekly play service at Whittock Rd Open Space, Stockwood. Because of the Coronavirus we are providing a limited, remote, service for 20 selected families. As social distancing measures lift we will be able to deliver face to face play services.

Until then you will receive a weekly play package. This play package will be a box or bag that includes materials selected by Scrapstore to support a range of creative play activities, you will be provided with some ideas on how to use them and a couple of instructional videos and/or fact sheets to help you to develop your activities.

Your first box is an Introductory Box which provides you with some basic materials as a tool kit for the other boxes and activities which will follow. These materials are to support all of the activities which will be delivered to you in the weeks to follow. You can pick up your resource boxes each week from the hub where you collected this one from and return the empty boxes ad bags the following week when you pick up your next weeks box. Following on from this the pack will be specifically related to the activities described and much smaller in size. So don't blow all your metrials in one gol!!
