You will need to drop off and pick up your child in the same place.

Nursery - Children's Centre gate - Drop off 8.45am Pick up 3.15pm

Reception - Back pedestrian entrance - Drop off 8.45am Pick up 3.15pm

Year I - Back pedestrian entrance - Drop off 8.40am Pick up 3pm

Year 2 - Front pedestrian entrance - Drop off 8.40am Pick up 3pm

Year 3 - Front pedestrian entrance - Drop off 8.50am Pick up 3.10pm

Year 4 - Back pedestrian entrance - Drop off 8.50am Pick up 3.10pm

Year 5 - Back pedestrian entrance - Drop off 9.00am Pick up 3.20pm

Year 6 - Front pedestrian entrance - Drop off 9.00am Pick up 3.20pm

While you are waiting to drop your child off or pick them up please remember to wear a face-covering, social distance from each other and keep 2m apart.

There will be 2 winning prizes for each class and 2 runner up prizes



Who can apply?:

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support through part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- . The guaranteed element of State Pension Credit
- Tax credits and have an annual income under £16.190 before tax
- The Working Tax Credit 4-week run on (the payment you get when you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)
- Universal Credit and has an annual income below £15,400

Or the parent / carer:

- Is a Zambrano carer (derivative right to reside in the UK under European law as the primary carer of a British child or dependent adult)
- Has Leave to remain with no recourse to public funds (NRPF) granted on family or private life (Article 8) grounds
- Is an 'Appeal rights exhausted' (ARE) asylum seeker receiving asylum support from the Home Office under section 4 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999

Or if your child:

- Receives Disability Living Allowance
- Has an Education, Health and Care Plan (EHCP)
- · Has a child protection plan
- Is looked after by us

- · Is a member of a travelling family
- Has left care but are not able to return home (are under a special guardianship order, child arrangements order or adoption order)
