Dinner Money



Parent Pay dinner accounts MUST be in credit at all times.

If you have a debt of over £10 your child will not be able to have a school dinner and you will be asked to bring in a packed lunch.

All children in Year 3 now need to pay for a school lunch unless they are entitled to free school meals.

There has been a slight increase to the cost of school meals. They are now charged at £2.30 a meal.
