

Local Performing Arts Holiday Club

Please find attached some information regarding a local performing arts holiday club that may be of interest to some of your children.

Sun Safe

The warm weather is staying for now so; please can we make sure children bring a drinks bottle into school, apply sun cream before school and the children have hats to be worn when out in the playground.

Lost Property

We have a significant amount of lost property in school at the minute. Please pop in to check it, if your child is missing items. Also please make sure everything is named.

Charging for trips and camps

We are going to be changing the wording on our trip letters moving forwards to ensure we are working within the guidelines set out for schools. The guidelines are a little confusing, so here is a brief summary of the information you need to know:

With trips that enhance the curriculum, we will now explicitly ask for voluntary contributions. However, you need to know the guidance states: 'It is important to note that no child should be excluded from an activity simply because his or her parents are unwilling or unable to pay. If insufficient voluntary contributions are raised to fund a visit, or the school cannot fund it from some other source, then it must be cancelled. This means if we do not get enough contributions from families, trips will be cancelled, as the school budget simply cannot afford to cover the costs of these trips. If you are genuinely struggling to pay for a trip, please speak to us and we can work with you, as we do have a tiny pot of money for these exceptional circumstances, but realistically to go ahead we need to receive 90% of the contributions.

Residential camps or activity days not relating to the school curriculum are the only activities that children cannot go on if a parent has not paid.

Shuffle up day and strikes

You may have seen in the news that there are two further strike days planned for Wednesday 5th and Friday 7th July. We will write to you nearer the time to confirm which classes are open and closed, however this has affected our transition plans.

Children will now meet their new teacher on Thursday 6th July (not Wed 5th) with the exception of the children going from Nursery to Reception, who will meet their teacher on Tuesday 4th July after registration. If children attend Nursery at the end of the week, they are welcome to come and join their peers on Tuesday morning for an hour as well.

First Aid Incidents

As you know, we try very hard to keep parents/carers informed about first-aid incidents but at present this relies on a member of our admin team sending you a first aid form which has often been completed by another member of staff. We are also increasingly aware of the substantial cost, time and environmental impact associated with the amount of paper and photocopying involved and the time taken to do this.

To help make improvements, we have researched systems and looked at what some other local schools are using successfully and have therefore decided, as a Trust, to use a service called Medical Tracker.

Medical Tracker not only allows us to inform parents/carers of first aid incidents and medication administration by email, but it also allows us to analyse the data we record.

Medical Tracker will be beneficial to you because:

- We can record and track first-aid incidents that involve your child
- We can record and track medication administration that involves your child
- You can be notified after a first-aid incident by email
- You can be notified after medication has been administered by email
- We can use the system to monitor health care plans

At Woodlands Academy, we are going to start rolling out the first aid element of this system from next week. This means you may receive first aid notifications in line with the information below or via Parentmail until all staff are trained. We will use it in the future for medication and health care plans, but will keep you informed as we transition.

To use Medical Tracker effectively, we will be using the email address you have registered with your ParentMail account. If you feel this is not correct, please log onto <u>ParentMail</u> and make the relevant changes. Please may we take this opportunity to remind you that the school office should be informed of

Please be assured that Medical Tracker is registered with the Data Protection Registrar and guarantees that all information you provide will be kept private and will not be passed on to any other organisation.


Our contact centre staff will only ever record the information reported - nothing about the reporter - it's impossible to find out who reported as it's not recorded anywhere.


