

#### **Complaints from Parents**

Over the last few weeks I have received a number of complaints about parents swearing outside school on the pavement. A number of parents are unhappy that their children are hearing bad language on their way into school. I would ask that parents stand away from the gate once they have dropped their child/children off to allow all children to enter school safely. Once the building work is complete the children will be able to enter school in different ways which should stop the pedestrian gate becoming crowded.

I am also aware that there have been issues with parking and cars driving on the pavement when dropping off and picking children up. If you have to drive to school please drive very slowly down Whittock Road so everyone can be safe.



## **School Lunch Payments**
