Thanks to the money raised we have managed to buy: 2 sofas, 2 book cases, a rug, a DVD stand, cushions, games, DVDs, story sacks and dressing up bags. Thank you! We have now spent all of the money received from the Foyles Foundation on books. The library is open every day for the children to change their books or play games and each class will visit the library each week. Over the course of the year we will be holding different events linked to the library that children will be able to join in with. I would like to say a big 'thank you' to Mrs Richards who has worked very hard to develop our new library.













Collecting from School

Recently we have had a few people arrive at school to collect children who we didn't know. If your child is being picked up by someone different please let the office know. If we don't know someone who comes to collect a child we will ring you to check. Thank you for your understanding with this matter.

Breakfast Club

We are very pleased that more and more children are using breakfast club and we are glad that we can provide this facility at school. Increasingly there are children who are attending breakfast club but not actually having breakfast. In order for us to continue to provide breakfast club that has no entrance fee I am asking that all children attending buy breakfast. It doesn't need to be much. Many schools charge an entrance fee to breakfast club. This is something we don't want to do but will if we need to.

Vacancy in School

We will soon be advertising for at least 1 SMSA to work in school supervising the children at lunchtimes. The hours will be 6 ¼ hours a week 11.45am – 1pm each day term time only. If you know of anyone who would be interested in this position they can contact the school office from 17th October onwards for more information and an application form.

Nursery Places

We have a few nursery places available for any child aged 3 or 4. Children can start Nursery the term after their 3rd birthday. If you know of anyone who is looking for a nursery place please ask them to contact the school for more information.

Free School Meals

If you are on certain benefits, your child may be entitled to free school meals. If you have children in Years 3-6, you need to visit the following website and apply online.

1 If your child is in Reception, Year 1 or 2, you can collect a form from the school office, complete the details and the office staff can complete the check for you online. Although these children are entitled to universal infant free school meals, your child will then be entitled to pupil premium funding.
