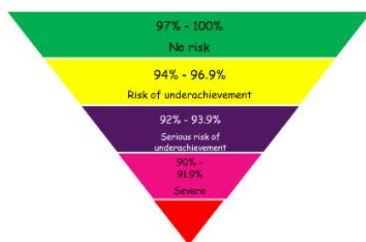

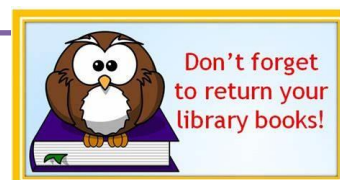
Parking Outside of School
