

Please find a list of the school uniform. Please make sure all items of uniform are labelled with their name.

- School navy blue sweatshirt/hoodie/cardigan (plain or with school logo and/or house)
- White polo T shirt or shirt (plain or with school logo and/or house)
- Grey/black trousers, smart shorts, pinafore or skirt (blue gingham dresses can be worn in appropriate weather)
- Plain black flat shoes or boots these can be trainers but they must be plain black
- Long hair must be tied back
- Children may wear a wrist watch but will be asked to remove it if it is a distraction - no smart watches
- Children with pierced ears may wear up to one pair of small stude preferably not to be worn on PE days - no dangly earrings or hoops
- Outdoor coats warm and waterproof in winter and rain proof in warmer months

Online Safety

We have been made aware of a safeguarding concern regarding children, some of whom are previous Woodlands' pupils, being targeted on Snapchat by older men pretending to be younger than they are, asking for personal details and photographs etc before sharing these photos on TikTok. The police are aware of this situation and are currently investigating it. We would recommend checking in with your children and their phones/other devices etc to ensure that they are not being contacted by strangers and that they continue to remain safe online.

The age recommendation for Snapchat is 16 years+ and the age recommendation for TikTok is 15 years+ so if your child has these apps installed an adult will either have had to give permission or the child will have had to falsify their date of birth. These age recommendations are in place to keep young people safe.









We're offering a group over the summer to support with moving up to secondary school.

What will we be doing?

The sessions will focus on common challenges and worries about moving to year 7. We'll learn strategies for overcoming these and how we can practice self-care. It can be challenging starting year 7 so this will be a space to share worries, meet other children and learn techniques to support with wellbeing.

Where and when will we meet?

The group will meet at Bridge Learning Campus from Monday 21st -Thursday 24th August. Each session will last for 2 hours, running from 10am-12pm.

Who will be there?

There will be 2 of us running the sessions - we are Education Mental Health Practitioners working in South Bristol schools.

We're offering the group to year 6's in South Bristol so there will be children from different schools.
