Monarch-Aleader of a country, e.g. a Kingor Queen.

**Heir-** The person next in line to throne who will take over when the current King or Queendies. **Regn**-The period of time that a monarch rules.

**Church of England** – Henry VIII created the Church of England so that he could divorce his first wife. The catholic church did not permit divorce.

**Reformation** – The act of changing (reforming) something. In this case the reformation of the church to remove the Pope's control.

Rape The head of the Roman Catholic Church.

**Divorce**- The legal end of a marriage.


**Beaution**-Beingput to death.

July 1588 The Spanish Armada setssail from Spain

19th July 1588 The English see the Armada. After seeing the Armada ships,

English ships chase them up the English Channel.

**27th July 1588** The Armada anchors of f Calais. The English send burning shipsat the Armada. The Spanish panic!

28th July 1588 English shipsattack the Armada near Gravelines in the

Netherlands. As the Spanish sailed off from Calais they were attacked by the English. This meant that they could not stop to pick up more soldiers waiting for them in the Netherlands

**30th July 1588** The Armada tries to make it backto Spain bygoing around the coast of Scotland.

AugustFierce storms off Scotland and the westcoast of Ireland wreck many Spanish ships.

SeptemberOnly two-thirds of the Armada war shipsmakeit backto Spain.
