This is a total of 65 late from 38 children which equates to 1,128 minutes or over 3 days of lost learning. This is slightly better than last time but not as good as we need it to be.



Last week our school had its first Challenge Partner review when teaching and learning and school systems were scrutinised by two senior leaders from other schools in England and a registered OFSTED inspector. The team decided that Woodlands is now a GOOD school. The reasons for this are identified in the written report, a copy of which will be emailed to parents before the end of term.


